

Hi everyone,

I am writing to invite you to the *Barrington Natural Heritage & Agricultural Fair*, at the *Warren Farm* off Rt. 4 on the weekend of August 28–29, and in particular to join us on *Sunday August 29* from 11:00 – 1:30, when Teresa and I will be leading a Traditional Music session under the tent in front of the farmhouse.

The Fair goes on from 10:00 - 4:00 both days, and features a variety of interesting events, including a Farmer's Market, lots of excellent local foods ready to eat, a variety of crafts, entertainment, educational activities and events, farm animals, music, and more.

It should be a fun event, and the music will make it more so. Teresa and I are hosting a fairly informal traditional music group from 11:00 - 1:30 on Sunday; presumably we'll take breaks during that time. We would like to invite anyone who is interested to join us. I'll bring my keyboard along, and make it available, play it at least part of the time if no one else wants to.

We expect to play a mixture of New England, Canadian and Swedish fiddle tunes, and whatever else anyone is interested in. I've assembled a basic tune list we can use for ideas, but we don't have to stick to it at all times. There should be opportunities to play together as a full band; but also for individuals to play their favorite tunes, or perhaps for small groups to play tunes together. I may call a couple dances if there's interest, so I may ask the band to play for a dance or two at some point. If you've been to the Canterbury Fiddler's Picnic (this year on Sun. Aug. 22!) it will probably bear some resemblance other than being a part of a larger event.

I'm sending along a flyer with the essential details and the tune list. I've put together a web site for the occasion and there's a web site for the event.
