- **Registration & Expenses.** See the Registration Form above. The \$75 fee does not include meals or housing. A few highlights:
 - → Discounts. Children under 12 are free. Youth and young adult dancers (12-25) are *balf price* (\$37.50). The Ist-Timer special price is \$50. It is available by pre-registration only and for those who have never pre-registered for the Full Weekend before.
 - → Individual sessions may be paid for at the door. (Fri., Sat. morn, Sat. afternoon, Sun. morn., are \$13 each. Sun. afternoon - \$8. Grand Dance - \$20. Full Weekend \$80.)
