

Star Hampshire 2012

WELCOME: We look forward to a weekend full of music, dance, and fun! Following is essential weekend info, committee contacts, and Star Island info. Read this letter carefully! Print it! Keep it for reference! An island map, ferry directions, and draft of the schedule are sent as separate attachments. We share the conference center with several other conferences (yoga, singing, women.)



“NEW SHOALERS”: If you have never been to Star Island, you are a “New Shoaler.” Please visit the Star Island Corporation website before September. There are interesting, useful, important, fun details therein – all of which will deepen your enjoyment of your first time in this special place. Start with the main SIC page (www.starisland.org) and [Important Info for Guests](#).

DIRECTIONS TO DOCK: Using MapQuest/GoogleMaps, enter “Isles of Shoals Steamship Co., Portsmouth, NH.” See online [Dock Directions](#) or attached *.pdf*

FERRY: M/V Thomas Lighton *departs Portsmouth at 2:55 pm on Friday, Sept. 14th*. Peggy Martin will welcome you at the ferry site. **Be at the dock 1-2 hours before departure – circa 1:00 pm**, especially to guarantee your luggage gets to Star on Friday. Allow time to endure *heavy* I-95 traffic, unload luggage, park, check in, and board. (If you’re late, your luggage might not arrive until Saturday. If you’re really late, it’s expensive/impossible to get to Star otherwise, so you may forfeit the weekend.) Reminder: The *ferry fee is included* in the conference fee but *parking will be added* to your SIC bill. (Fee is \$30 *per car* – Carpool! Save \$!) **We get back to Portsmouth at 4:45pm on Sunday, Sept. 16.** More [Boats and Parking Info](#) on SIC site.

LUGGAGE: Limits on checked baggage are strictly enforced. Each person may bring:

- **“checked” baggage**, which goes on another boat (1 bag <40 lbs –or– 2 bags <25 lbs each.) Duffle bags without wheels are best. Don’t put alcohol or prescriptions in checked bags.
- **one small carry-on bag** (backpack/small tote) – bring prescriptions in carry-on!
NOTE: No alcohol allowed on the Thomas Lighton! (See “Social Hour” below.)
- **a specialty item**, such as a musical instrument

STUFF TO BRING: Weather can range from “Sunny and 85” to “Wind, rain, and 39.” The Star Island facility provides bedding, towels/washcloths. Heat is only in some common spaces. Bring:

- clothes, footwear, outerwear, raingear for ***all weather conditions***—hot, cold, dry, wet
- comfortable dance shoes
- flashlight/headlamp – for walking on rocky paths at night
- optional byob for social hour (see below)
- snack contribution (see below)
- water bottle/mug/cup to use at dance sessions
- 7 day supply of essential medications – in case extreme weather keeps us on the island
- sleeping bag or warm blanket – esp. if you get cold easily and/or low temps are predicted.
- tempting items for the ***Silent Auction*** to raise funds supporting Star Island.

FESTIVE ATTIRE: On Sat. night, many dancers dress fancy, especially celestial/ocean themes.

SNACKS & POTLUCK TREATS: We have a water jug in the dance hall. Please BYO water bottle/mug/cup. For the evening dances, *please bring a snack* to share (homemade goodies, crackers, fruit, garden treats, etc.) Last names starting A-L share on Friday, and M-Z folks share on Saturday.

SOCIAL HOUR: Star Island Corp. has no liquor license. Saturday afternoon is our BYO "Social Hour" (alcohol permitted only at the designated location.) NOTE: If you BYO alcohol, label your bottle(s). They'll go in a box on a separate boat. (No alcohol on the Thomas Loughton. Don't stash in a carry-on)

CANDLELIGHT CHAPEL: For Saturday's informal chapel service (a Star Island tradition), we invite you to share a reading, poem, song, music, etc. A sign-up sheet will circulate on Star.

PARTICIPATION: Enrich the experience for all! Build community! Share your talents, skills, thoughts, etc. throughout the weekend — whether program-related or just a fun diversion.

ECOLOGY & FIRE SAFETY: The Star Island Corp. asks us to be conscious of the delicate island environment. Don't pick flowers or collect animal, plant, or mineral samples. Bring biodegradable personal care products, pack food/snacks in reusable containers, and take as much of your personal trash off the island with you as possible. NOTE: Given fire safety and electrical system limitations, please do not bring appliances with heating elements (heating pads, irons, hot water immersion heaters, etc.) If you must use a hair dryer, there are safe outlets in the shower areas.

SHOWERS: Showers on Star Island depend on cistern water level. We expect to be allotted two showers during the weekend. Bring what you need for a good sponge bath in your room in case water supply limits showers to one. (This hasn't happened in the past, but is possible.)

CELL PHONES: Cell phones compromise the peaceful atmosphere of retreat on Star Island. If you must bring yours, please turn it off. If an important call is expected, set it to vibrate and move to a private area to answer. If you must make a cell phone call, please do it from your bedroom.

STUFF NOT TO BRING: Illegal drugs, fireworks, firearms, valuables. (Nuff said.)

GROUP PHOTO: Check the program schedule for time and location. Smile!

OTHERS JOINING OUR DANCE SESSIONS: We welcome "Pelicans" (island staff) at the Fri or Sat night dance parties, and other conference attendees may join us too. However, to ensure that all of our attendees dance as much as they like during the weekend, please seek dance partners from within our group before those from outside our conference.

HOTEL BILL: Your Star Island Corp. bill includes room/board/ferry fees (less \$100 R/B/F deposit), ~\$4 fuel surcharge, \$30/car parking, and ~\$16/lobster (see next section). Any discounts for room/board (such as "[10/10 Bring a Friend](#)") will be calculated by SIC. [Mail printed [10/10 forms](#) to Chrissy Fowler in advance at address below.] Bills should be ready Saturday morning. Please pay promptly. Visa/MasterCard accepted but *Check or Cash is preferred.*

LOBSTER TICKETS: Lobsters for Saturday supper cost ~\$16 each. *Pre-orders due 9/1/12.* (ktaadn_me@hotmail.com) Midday Saturday, get your lobster ticket from the front desk. (A convenient time to pay your hotel bill!) Definitely do this before the Saturday “Social Hour”.

MEDICAL CONSIDERATIONS: Star Island is remote. Visitors come to the island at their own risk, and individuals with chronic medical conditions should consult their physicians. “Normal” island hazards include poison ivy, seagulls, and injuries from bare feet (strongly discouraged.) The first aid station on the island is equipped only for basic emergencies and first aid. In emergencies, it is merely a stop gap until patients can be transported to a hospital. Travel time to the nearest off-island medical facility (Portsmouth Reg. Hosp.) is a minimum of 1 hour. Notify island medical staff about all prescription drugs, and bring those in your carry-on. Controlled medications must be kept under lock & key at all times (lock boxes provided by SIC.)

SUNDAY DINNER in PORTSMOUTH:

Consider attending the Star Hampshire farewell meal & brew on the mainland (restaurant TBD.)

MAJOR STORM CONTINGENCY: Given the island location, there is a remote chance that the weekend could be canceled or adjusted because of a major storm or hurricane. If threatening weather is predicted for Friday, and the weekend status changes, we will update attendees via email. You may also call Peggy Martin at (603) 726-3033. Deadline for a decision regarding total cancellation shall be 5:00 pm Thursday, Sept. 13.

This is a non-profit event. If the event is completely canceled by Thursday at 5:00 pm, then 75% -100% of the program fee will be refunded. (We have certain fixed expenses, even with a cancellation.) Also, should the event be canceled or altered, the organizers and Star Island Corporation cannot be responsible for participants’ pre-paid travel expenses (e.g. airline tickets).
