

## *Directions to Canterbury Center*

### **From the Seacoast Area:**

- ❖ Take Route 4 West through the Epsom Traffic Circle. Go through the traffic light in Chichester with the two gas stations, and past a third gas station on the left. Shortly after that look for Central New Hampshire Animal Care on the right, and take a right turn immediately after onto King Road.
  - ❖ Take King Road until it ends, and take a right onto Rt. 106. [If you missed King Road you can stay on Rt. 4 until it intersects with Rt. 106 as well; just follow the signs.]
  - ❖ Stay on Rt. 106 for several minutes. The speed limit will go down to 45, you'll see the 106 Beanstalk, signs for the Canterbury Shaker Village, and there will be a traffic light. Take a left on Shaker Road at the light.
  - ❖ After a few minutes the speed limit will go down to 35. Take a left at the top of a small hill onto Baptist Road - it's the only significant and paved left turn off Shaker Road, and it's pretty obvious.
  - ❖ Follow Baptist Road into the center of town. The Gazebo should be in plain sight. In case of rain: In town take a right onto Hackleboro Road, and the Parish House is just after the country store on the left. Look for a place to park.

### **From the West:**

- ❖ Take I-89 to I-93 North. Get off I-93 at Exit 17 and turn left onto Hoit Road.
- ❖ Immediately turn left onto Boyce Road and stay on it until it ends.
- ❖ When it ends you come to the intersection of Rt. 132 (not well marked). Take a left onto 132. (You could go sort of straight on a dirt road but that would be a bad idea although it gets you there eventually.)
- ❖ After 2-3 miles or so (approximately) you'll see a sign for Canterbury Center and Canterbury Shaker Village. Follow the signs and take a right at that point onto Kimball Pond Road. Stay on it until you get into town. At some point it makes a right-angle turn to the left, but stay on Kimball Pond Road.
- ❖ When you come to the center of town the Gazebo should be in plain sight. In case of rain: Go straight across the main road onto Hackleboro Road, and the Parish House is on the left just after the country store. Look for a place to park.
