Here we present you with some details you may find important.

- Registration & Expenses.** See the Registration Form above. The \$75 fee **does not** include meals or housing. A few highlights:
  - ➔ **Discounts.** Children under 12 are *free*. Youth and young adult dancers (12-25) are *half price* (\$37.50). The 1<sup>st</sup>-Timer special price is \$50. It is available by *pre-registration only* and for those who have never pre-registered for the Full Weekend before.
  - ➔ **Individual sessions** may be paid for at the door. (Fri., Sat. morn, Sat. afternoon, Sun. morn., are \$13 each. Sun. afternoon - \$8. Grand Dance - \$20. Full Weekend \$80.)
  - ➔ For more information: Dave Bateman; see end for details.
- Meals.** Meals are an **additional cost** and are available **only** by pre-registration. See the Registration Form above for costs.
  - ➔ Sorry, aside from a **basic vegetarian** option, we cannot accommodate special dietary needs.
  - ➔ **Registrations** that include meals **must be received by 12/31/08!** **Cancellations** must be received before 1/02/09 in order to receive a refund for meal charges.
- Lodging & Hospitality:** You'll need to find a place to stay. The *New England Center* and *Holiday Inn Express* are in Durham.

- ➔ We keep an updated list of Seacoast-area **lodgings** on the web site; contact *Peter Thompson* (see end) about such topics.
  - ➔ Are you local and able to *offer* one or more people from out of town a *place to stay*? Contact Peter Thompson (see end).
