Here we present you with some details you may find important.

1. **Registration & Expenses.** See the Registration Form above. The \$80 fee **does not** include meals or housing. A few highlights:
 - ➔ **Discounts.** Children under 12 are *free*. Youth and young adult dancers (12-25) are *half price* (\$40). The 1st-Timer special price is \$60. It is available by *pre-registration only* and for those who have never pre-registered for the Full Weekend before.
 - ➔ **Individual sessions** may be paid for at the door. (Fri., Sat. morn, Sat. afternoon, Sun. morn., are \$13 each. Sun. afternoon - \$8. Grand Dance - \$20. Full Weekend \$80.)
 - ➔ For more information: Dave Bateman; see end for details.
2. **Meals.** Meals are an **additional cost** and are available **only** by pre-registration. See the Registration Form above for costs.
 - ➔ Sorry, aside from a **basic vegetarian** option, we cannot accommodate special dietary needs.
 - ➔ **Registrations** that include meals **must be received by 12/31/09!** **Cancellations** must be received before 1/02/10 in order to receive a refund for meal charges.
3. **Lodging & Hospitality:** You'll need to find a place to stay. The *New England Center* and *Holiday Inn Express* are in Durham.

 - ➔ Are you local and able to *offer a place to stay* to one or more people from out of town? Contact Peter Thompson (see end).
4. **Work Exchange.** We can use *your help* at the Weekend. **Volunteer** for several hours & attend the Weekend for only \$25 (meals not included). The number of volunteers is limited. Apply early! Contact Dave Bateman for information (see end).
